Milford's Kathy Brown & Laraine Moore were the first sent home by Croot and Hill (17-10). A comfortable win over Hobsonville's Elizabeth Ballam and Hanaan Shahwan (26-14). Into the Semis and what a semi up against Takapuna's Wendy Jensen and Robyne Walker, with Croot and Hill progressing to the final with win (12-8). Mairangi Bay's Theresa Rogers & Sheryl Wellington had been making their way to the final on the bottom half of the draw, defeating Orewa's Elaine McClintock & Kerin Roberts (19-8) to make the final. First end of the final and it is five to Croot and Hill, but Mairangi come back to draw the scores after five ends (5-5).
