The Wily Old Fox

Twenty-five entries were drawn Thursday evening for the Men's Championship Singles to be played out over the three days of Labour Weekend. A bye existed, but no stress really, as byes are part of a two-life system, which this Championship was being played under. The call went out Friday to fill the bye and Sydney Walker moved from the markers list into the draw.

Saturday dawned a stunner with the field spread across the two greens it was down to business, two life system, no time limit. The bye filled the previous day, but on the morning of play two defaults, one entry we still haven't heard from.

After round two the field was starting to shape out. Joseph Korkis, William Tonga, Jack Huriwai, Nigel Drew, David Eades, Mark Rumble and Daymon Pierson all sat above the line with both lives in tact. Those below the line, had lost a life, Steve Arms, Warren Lush, Chad Nathan, Martin Short, Mike Turner, Doug Campbell, Peery Meinung, Adam Richardson, Curtis Ennor, Kieran Jones and Gary Wallace, but still everything to play for.

While Korkis was enjoying a bye, defending champion Drew and Club newcomer Eades fought a furious battle on A5 with a draw drive mentality evident though the game, Drew winning out (21-14). Huriwai "the wily old fox" accounted for third year Tonga (21-12). Pierson showed his form spanking Rumble (21-5). Below the line Arms smashed Lush (21-2), Nathan won by default, Shot bowed out to Turner (20-21), Campbell sent Meinung home (21-16), Richardson defeated past champion Ennor (21-12).

Second year Jones pipped Wallace (21-20).

Round four and the final for Saturday Huriwai sat out the bye, Drew dropped below the line going down to Pierson (21-18). Two lifer Korkis won over one lifer Arms (21-12).

Turner squeezed past Nathan (21-19), Richardson drew past Campbell (21-14), battle of the juniors saw Jones progress beating Tonga (21-17). Rumble coming off the spanking the previous round was dealt a killer blow defeated by Eades (21-10).

Sunday, round five, all play on the top green, not a breath of wind, superb conditions for bowls. Pierson kicked Korkis to below the line (21-5). Huriwai suffered a scare just slipping past one lifer Mike Turner (21-18). Jones carried on his dream run taking out Richardson (21-11). The battle of the heavy hitters Eades versus Drew saw Eades come out on top (21-11).

Round six, Pierson's turn with the bye. Jones dream run came crashing down, going down (21-10) to Huriwai. Eades showed his dominance and experiences dispatching Korkis to the Clubrooms (21-2).

Round Seven, Huriwai defeated at the hands of Pierson (21-7), while Eades had the bye. Round eight and Huriwai with the bye. Pierson looking to be in an exceptional play space progressed to be in the box seat beating Eades (21-9).

Monday, round ten, a potential final with play underway midday and for the first time over-cast and a tricky breeze to contend with. Pierson (two lives) versus Huriwai (one life). A win here Pierson and the Champions title is all his. While for Huriwai to get his hands on the trophy, a trophy he has won twice before, he must go the long way and beat Pierson twice.

Pierson jumped out to a lead (8-0) with two threes and a two in the opening three ends. Was this to carry on and would Pierson dominate as he had been, only one player had got double figures against him at this point. By the time the eleventh end had been played the scores were locked up (12-12) and those in attendance had been treated to some truly outstanding bowls with heads continuously changing. Shot for shot continued and the standard from both players a pleasure to watch. Nineteenth end and the scores all locked up again (17-17), the scores had never been further than two shots apart. The following two ends shots were traded and all locked up again (18-18). Huriwai managed to secure a two and a one to take the win and force a winner takes all final.

A battle of two one lifers is what the Championship had come down to. Pierson had lost his advantage of the two lives, this was to be a winner takes all final and it promised much. Huriwai took the early lead, but the scores were all locked up after seven ends (7-7). This middle part of the game saw more killed ends and drives than across all rounds previously. A section of play from Pierson vastly different from what he had been playing. But he got results before settling back into the style of play we had become a custom to over the weekend. Nineteen ends completed and the score all locked up again (13-13). Huriwai moved ahead picking up singles on the next four ends (13-17) before Pierson came back with two twos (17-17). The following end (end twenty-nine) proved to be the final end with Huriwai claiming two shots (21-19) and the Men's Championship Singles crown for the season. 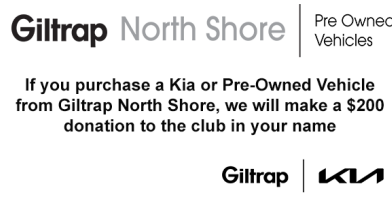

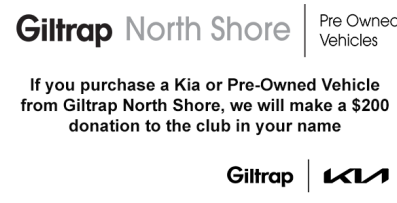
